At Woodside we value:

- ⇒ Deliberate practice and effective effort
- ⇒ Struggle and mistakes as learning tools
- ⇒ The brain and its capacity to learn
- ⇒ The process being as important as the outcome
- ⇒ High expectations for all children

A child's mindset about a subject or skill is highly influenced by their parent's belief. Encourage your child by saying:

- ⇒ It is your effort/hard work/practise that has made you so successful.
- ⇒ Everybody has potential. What really impresses me is when you have a go even when you aren't sure you will get it right. Mistakes are okay when you are learning.
- ⇒ Everybody has the ability to get better. That's how the brain works.
- ⇒ I can see that you are practising that skill.
